Introducing The Norfolk Austin Seven Club.

The **Norfolk Austin Seven Club** was formed in January 2005, to foster interest in the preservation and use of Pre-War Austin Sevens, its variants, other Austin cars and old cars in general. In March 2017 we had 96 joint memberships (a total of 174 joint members who have equal voting rights in the club), with over 140 Austin 7s and other pre-war cars.

The Monthly Meetings are normally held on the evening of the 3rd Tuesday of each month, January through to November, from about 7.30 pm onwards, at the Jubilee Hall, East Tuddenham, near Norwich (just off the A47). The idea is to have a chat with friends who have a similar interest in Austin Sevens and old cars in general, over a convivial drink. We often have a guest speaker. The December meeting is our Club Dinner and usually takes place on the 2nd Tuesday (instead of the 3rd Tuesday).

During the year we have a full calendar of events and attend a wide variety of shows and rallies. We are only too willing to help members with what ever they want to do so that they can enjoy their Austin 7 to the full. If you are looking for an Austin 7 we can help and if you need advice on repairs and maintenance we can help as well.

The NA7C is a Member of the Austin Seven Clubs Association, so it comes under the association's insurance "umbrella" for Public Liability Insurance cover. Being members of the A7CA means that members of the Norfolk Austin Seven Club are able to get the same benefits as given to other Austin Seven car clubs with respect to car insurance by Richard Hoskins under their Classic Car Insurance Scheme.

We are also a member of the Federation of British Historic Vehicle Clubs who look after our interests as far as dealing with politicians – both British and E.U. – and to maintain our freedom to use Yesterday's Vehicles on Tomorrow's Roads.

The cost of membership to the NA7C is £15 per year. Each Member may nominate one family member, partner, or friend as a Joint Member, who shall also have full club rights at no extra cost.

All members receive the quarterly newsletter of the NA7C, The NORFOLK NA7TER. If you wish to receive copies of the A7CA quarterly magazine ("The Grey Mag"), there is an extra annual cost of £8 (to cover the purchase cost and postage).

Those members who are on broadband can receive copies of other Austin 7 Clubs magazines via email if they wish. The club also has a website – www.na7c.co.uk – with useful information and an up-to-date calendar of events.

We have a Club Car Valuer who can value your car, on a club night, by prior arrangement through the Club Chairman, for a nominal charge of £10 (which will go towards club funds). We are also accredited by the DVLA to inspect vehicles in support of applications for original or age-related registrations.
